

DR-TB STAT: Summary and Updates

April, 2016

Overall:

- Current number of patients on BDQ under program conditions: **3374**
 - 1904 South Africa; 198 Belarus; 174 Georgia; 82 Armenia, 47 Swaziland, 827 Russia, 24 Indonesia, 6 PNG; 21 Lesotho; 5 Peru; 51 Kazakhstan; 5 Kenya, 30 Viet Nam
 - Total number CU = **766**.
 - Current number of BDQ orders from GDF: **4175**
- Current number of patients on DLM under program conditions and CU: **180** according to company
 - 7 from MSF in Belarus; 8 from MSF in Armenia; 6 from MSF in Georgia= **201** total
 - Current number of DLM orders from GDF: **0**

Country Updates:

- Georgia: Continuing to do well with BDQ; early introduction of DLM via MSF
- Indonesia: 24 patients in 3 sites and active ongoing screening sites actively screening patients; some clinical challenges in management and also patients not “being willing” to enroll
- India: Received 500 courses from Janssen, program officially launched on March 21. Likely to start first patients in May as the focus is on XDR and pre-XDR; possibly eligible patients are on “waiting list” for SLDST
- Vietnam: doing well with more rapid pace of enrollment; if this pace continues they will use all their BDQ before it expires
- Philippines: Plan to start on May 27
- South Africa: continues to progress well and accounts for almost 2/3 of BDQ use globally DLM discussions ongoing for 200 treatment courses.
- Lesotho: 21 patients on therapy
- Peru: 5 patients started to date
- Swaziland: BDQ scale-up continues; preparing to submit order for DLM and will be the first country to obtain DLM for program use from GDF.
- Kenya: Continuing to develop national plan, 5 patients on BDQ through MSF
- China: No formal updates, but Janssen was told they will hear about the registration request sometime in the next few months
- Russia: continue to make progress throughout the country

- Mozambique: working on final documentation to place order for about 200 patients; still some challenges getting documents in Portuguese.
- PNG: GLC recommendations clarified and posted on website April 1 (http://www.wpro.who.int/papuanewguinea/areas/tb_leprosy/daru_update/en/); planning to order for 60 patients
- Ukraine: No new updates; trying to access BDQ for 1 patient via CU
