

DR-TB STAT: Summary and Updates

June, 2016

Overall:

- Current number of patients on BDQ under program conditions: **4058**
 - 2408 South Africa; 228 Belarus; 184 Georgia; 87 Armenia, 53 Swaziland, 827 Russia, 35 Indonesia, 8 PNG; 32 Lesotho; 15 Peru; 95 Kazakhstan; 6 Kenya, 42 Viet Nam; 3 Philippines; 12 Latvia; 15 Estonia; 6 Haiti; 2 India)
 - Total number CU= **766**.
 - Current number of BDQ orders from GDF: **4257**
- Current number of patients on DLM under program conditions and CU: **180** according to company.
 - 7 from MSF in Belarus; 9 from MSF in Armenia; 21 from MSF in Georgia; 12 from MSF in South Africa/Khayelitsha; 8 Latvia; 10 Estonia; 2 Kazakhstan (and 70 course just cleared customs) = **249 total**
 - Current number of DLM orders from GDF: **567**

Country Updates:

- Georgia: Continuing to do well with BDQ; early introduction of DLM via MSF
- Indonesia: 35 patients in 3 sites and active ongoing screening sites actively screening patients; some clinical challenges in management and also patients not “being willing” to enroll
- India: Began enrolling first patients in June; 2 as of today but all six sites ready to go
- Vietnam: doing well in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City; slower in Can Tho
- Philippines: Began enrolling in June
- South Africa: continues to progress well and accounts for 60% of BDQ use globally DLM discussions ongoing for 200 treatment courses but awaiting approval from MCC; 12 on DLM through MSF.
- Lesotho: 32 patients on therapy
- Peru: 15 patients started to date
- Swaziland: BDQ scale-up continues; preparing to submit order for DLM
- Kenya: Continuing to develop national plan, 6 patients on BDQ through MSF
- China: No formal updates, but Janssen was told they will hear about the registration request sometime in the next few months
- Russia: continue to make progress throughout the country but not getting monthly updates anymore
- Mozambique: working on final documentation to place order for about 200 patients; still some challenges getting documents in Portuguese; MSF to start 10 patients.

- PNG: placed order for 85 patients but scaled back to 30 in first shipment; proposal for support submitted to USAID
- Ukraine: No new updates; trying to access BDQ for 1 patient via CU but no way to import
- Mexico: Still awaiting input from USAID about qualifying for donation. National meeting held in June to update the situation.
- Haiti: Started enrolling in June, may need another shipment of BDQ soon.

Issues

- Slow progress in BDQ ordering
- Criteria for single-country consideration for USAID donation program
- Coordination with 2016 MDR-TB updates and shortened regimens
- Expiration of stock and expansion of criteria to include toxicity/drug substitution

Figure 1: Progress in BDQ and DLM by Month

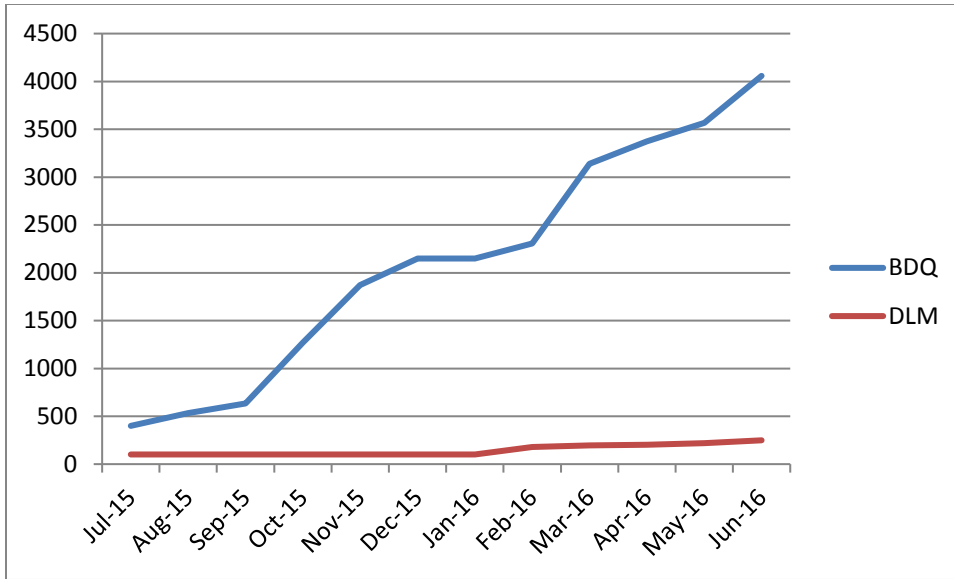


Figure 2: Progress in BDQ and DLM by Month Compared with Estimated Need
